

FEI Competitor Categories (Art 519)

FEI Competitor categories for Eventing define a recognition of proven competence of the Competitor at a certain level. Such categories will determine the different requirements of participation according to the Matrix of FEI and Canadian Eligibility Requirements.

Competitors are categorized by the FEI (Uncategorised , D, C, B, A) according to their performance in a rolling eight year period as defined in the following table. The Competitor category will be updated according to their performance at the end of the calendar year by the FEI.

| Rider Category | Performance Criteria |
|-----------------------|-----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| D | Fifteen (15) MER at FEI CICs or CCIs of one (1) star level or above; or five (5) MERs at FEI CICs or CCIs competitions at higher level. |
| C | Fifteen(15) MER at FEI CICs or CCIs of two (2) star level or above; or five (5) MERs at FEI CICs or CCIs competitions at higher level. |
| B | Fifteen (15) MER at FEI CICs or CCIs of three (3) star level or above; of five (5) MERs at FEI CCIs competitions at four star level. |
| A | Fifteen (15) MER at FEI CICs or CCIs of three (3) star level or above at which five are at four star level |
