National Qualifying Result (NQR) is the score requirement set for each phase in order for the competition to count as a qualifier:

- Dressage Score earned in a USEF Dressage Test: No more than 50 penalty points.
- Dressage Score earned in a FEI Dressage Test: No more than 75 penalty points.
- Cross-country Score: No Cross-country jump penalties and no more than 36 time penalties.
- Show Jumping: No more than 16 Show Jumping jump penalties. Time penalties are not applicable for qualification purposes.
- 25 penalties points received for Dangerous Riding will not achieve a National Qualifying result.

## APPLICABLE TO ALL NATIONAL LEVELS LISTED IN THE CHART ABOVE:

- 1. At least one of the qualifying competitions must be obtained in the twelve month period prior to the competition.
